**Apprentice Classical (auditioning in grades 3-8)**

Violin	<ul> <li>Three (3) major scales:</li> <li>Two (2) octaves: F, D, Bb.</li> <li>Two (2) notes per bow at least</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Viola	<ul> <li>Three (3) major scales:</li> <li>Two (2) octaves: D, A (low 1)</li> <li>One (1) octave: C</li> <li>Two (2) notes per bow at least</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Cello	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales:</li> <li>One (1) octave: C, F</li> <li>One (1) melodic minor scale:</li> <li>One (1) octave: g</li> <li>Two (2) notes per bow at least</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Bass	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales:</li> <li>Two (2) octaves: C, A</li> <li>One (1) melodic minor scale:</li> <li>Two (2) octaves: g</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Flute	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)</li> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> <li>One (1) octave chromatic scale</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Clarinet	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)</li> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> <li>One (1) octave chromatic scale</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Oboe	• Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.

Bassoon	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)</li> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Trumpet	<ul> <li>One (1) octave chromatic scale</li> <li>Two (2) major scales:         <ul> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves: G, A</li> </ul> </li> <li>One (1) melodic minor scale:         <ul> <li>One (1) octave: c</li> </ul> </li> <li>One (1) octave chromatic scale</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility. Trombone	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)</li> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Tuba	<ul> <li>One (1) octave chromatic scale</li> <li>Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)         <ul> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> </ul> </li> <li>One (1) octave chromatic scale</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Percussion	<ul> <li>Snare Drum: roll crescendo and diminuendo for at least eight (8) beats total</li> <li>Mallets: Two (2) major scales up to 4 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A, Ab, E) with its relative melodic minor scales</li> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Нагр	<ul> <li>One (1) major scale:</li> <li>C major (2<sup>nd</sup> finger, hands separate) - In thirds</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting pieces demonstrating technique and lyrical facility.  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.

Voice	<ul> <li>One (1) major scale         <ul> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> </ul> </li> <li>Chromatic scale - start on a given pitch and be able to sing up or down 3 half steps and land on the correct note.</li> </ul>	Two (2) songs with contrasting styles – no pop or jazz songs  Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Piano	<ul> <li>Three (3) major scales up to 4 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A, Db, E)</li> <li>Three (3) octaves</li> <li>Chromatic scale</li> </ul>	Two (2) contrasting solo pieces (not from a method book) demonstrating technique and lyrical facility  Total time should fill at least 5 minutes of music.
Conducting	<ul> <li>Two (2) octaves</li> <li>Music Theory Assessment – taken at the live audition         <ul> <li>This will test your basic skills in music theory - time signatures, key signatures, rhythms, melodic dictation.</li> </ul> </li> <li>For practice, go to <a href="https://www.musictheory.net">www.musictheory.net</a></li> </ul>	Be able to execute the following conducting patterns while counting out loud: 4/4, 3/4, 2/4, 6/8 (counting in 6 and 2); how do you conduct something soft vs. something loud; something with short notes vs. something with long notes.  If you have a piece to bring to the audition to conduct for us (to silence), you may do so, but you are not required to. (Please bring a copy of the piece for the judges.)  If you bring one, your piece should be no more than 3 minutes.
Composition	<ul> <li>Music Theory Assessment – taken at the live audition</li> <li>This will test your basic skills in music theory - time signatures, key signatures, rhythms, melodic dictation.</li> <li>For practice, go to <a href="www.musictheory.net">www.musictheory.net</a>.</li> <li>We will ask you to do some composition at this time as well.</li> </ul>	Submit 2 sample scores. Sample scores should be a minimum of 64 measures or about 2 minutes each. If you are invited to audition, your scores must be submitted electronically one week prior to the audition date.

Horns (Trumpet, trombone)	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)</li> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> <li>Blues scale</li> </ul>	Blues in Bb and a contrasting standard of your choice demonstrating technique and lyrical facility – total of at least 3 minutes of music
Guitar	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)</li> <li>One (1) or two (2) octaves</li> <li>Blues scale</li> </ul>	Blues in Bb and a contrasting standard of your choice demonstrating technique and lyrical facility – total of at least 3 minutes of music

Total time of both pieces should be between 3 and 6 minutes.
Piano	<ul> <li>Two (2) major scales up to 3 sharps and flats (C, F, G, Bb, D, Eb, A)</li> <li>Two (2) octaves</li> <li>Blues scale</li> </ul>	Blues in Bb and a contrasting standard of your choice demonstrating technique and lyrical facility – total of at least 3 minutes of music
